# Digital Equity – P12 Data

## P12 School Digital Equity Survey - June 2020

- 50% of schools responded
  - 300K+ students did not have a device
  - 200K+ students did not have internet access
  - Top barrier: Cost
  - Teachers: 4200 without device, 3500 without internet
  - LMS: Google

- Fall 2020 BEDS (School-Level)
- (Re-Issue) Digital Equity Survey - October
- Fall 2021 Student-Level Data
